Feline Vaccination Schedule

Recommended (Core) Vaccines

Disease	Description	Primary kitten series (<16 weeks)	Primary adult series (>16 weeks)	Booster
Feline viral rhinotracheitis	Upper respiratory, ocular	1 dose at 6-8 weeks, then every 3-4 weeks until 16 weeks old	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart	1 dose 1 year after primary series, then every 3 years
Calicivirus	Upper respiratory	Same as above	Same as above	Same as above
Panleukopenia	Gastrointestinal, hematologic	Same as above	Same as above	Same as above
Rabies (killed virus)*	Neurologic, fatal, transmissible to humans	1 dose at 16 weeks	1 dose	1 dose 1 year after first dose, then every 3 years
Rabies (canarypox vectored)*	Same as above	Same as above	Same as above	Annual
Feline leukemia virus	Immunosuppressive, predisposes to cancer	2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart, at 12 weeks or older	Dependent on risk	Annual, dependent on risk
